REGULATIONS.

Entries are made and accepted subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Association. A copy of this is obtainable from the PB A&P Assn. office. All exhibitors should read and be conversant with applicable regulations. Entries are further subject to any conditions set out in the Schedule as applying to specific sections or classes. Regulations, which are of particular application to entries in the sheep section, are:

Part R20: No DOGS other than those officially entered in Scheduled competitions, shall be permitted on the grounds.

R40: In all cases where not otherwise stated, the 2nd and 3rd prize money (except in cases of specific donations) may be withheld respectively where there are less than 3 or 5 entries in classes.

R41: In the event that no 1st and/or 2nd placing is awarded, and only a 2nd and/or 3rd placing is awarded, the prize money paid will be that for 2nd or 3rd only, still subject to R40 preceding.

R42: Prizes will be paid direct to prize winners during the show

R82: All sheep must be shown in the wool, but those classes listed as shorn must not be shorn before 20th July unless otherwise stated.

ENTRIES: must be on an official entry form and signed by the exhibitor or some person authorised by him or her. All entries correctly made and accompanied by payment of the correct fees shall be accepted. By signing the entry form you accept the Association's conditions of entry and indemnify the Association under the provisions of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015

EXHIBITORS must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident or illness or damage caused by the animal.

PERIOD OF DISPLAY: all sheep are to be penned by 8.15am. Friday unless otherwise stated, and remain penned for display until 4.00 pm Saturday

ENTRIES: all fleeces, together with an Official Sheep Entry form obtainable from the Section Steward, together with the payment of entry fee must be delivered to the Wool Room at the Showgrounds by 12.30 p.m. Wednesday 15 October 2021.

Note: Fleeces **may be sold** at the Show

ENTRY FEES: \$5.00 GST inclusive

PRIZE MONEY: 1st \$15.00, 2nd \$10.00, 3rd \$5.00 unless otherwise stated

LABELS: A label giving class number and the exhibitor's name must be attached to each fleece. All containers must be clearly marked. No responsibility for unmarked containers.

The Committee reserves the right to change the classes or conditions from time to time according to circumstances. If entry is made in Station Name, the Exhibitor's name must also be mentioned. All fleeces to be from current season's shearing.

PLEASE NOTE: Classes 516 and 517 state "Machine grab sample".

Suggested weights to be used as a guide in selections:

Fine Wool Hoggets	2.75kg;
Medium Hoggets	3.50kg;
Strong Hoggets	3.75kg;
Fine Marino	

MERINO:

Hogget	2.5kg & up;
Fine Mature	3.00kg;

All fleeces to be shown skirted without bellies, neck fold or heavy condition points.

This allows selection at the wool table during normal shearing procedure.

- 511 Fleece from Hogget, shorn as a lamb, 28 to 33 microns.
- 512 Fleece from Hogget, shorn as a lamb, 33.5 to 35.5 micron
- 513 Fleece from Hogget, shorn as a lamb, 36 micron and stronger
- 514 Fleeces from Hogget, must be Merino or Merino cross, 24 microns or finer.
- 515 Fleece from mature sheep - must be Merino or Merino cross
- 516 Mature Shears – entrant to provide a 1 - 2kg. Machine grab sample; either 75mm-100mm or 75mm-125mm
- 517 Hogget Shears – entrant to provide a 1 - 2kg. Machine grab sample; either 75mm-100mm or 75mm-125mm
